CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Recyclables are collected curbside every other week by Waste Management under contract with the Village of Shorewood. For route and schedule information, please visit www.villageofshorewood.org/recycling



PAPER

Newspapers, corrugated cardboard, paperboard, magazines, office paper, junk mail, phone books and paper cardboard dairy and juice cartons.

CARBORD MUST BE CUT AND BUNDLED INTO 2x2 FT SECTIONS



PLASTICS

Food and other containers coded 1-7.



GLASS

Clear, brown or green food or beverage containers.



METALS

Aluminum cans, aluminum foil and bakeware, steel & tin.

Under the Village's current contract with Waste Management, HALF of the proceeds from the sale of recyclable materials collected CURBSIDE are returned to the Village. This rebate does NOT apply to materials collected at the recycling center. Please help us to keep recycling even more economical – recycle at home!

DPW RECYCLING CENTER – WEEKDAY MATERIALS AND HOURS

All materials collected curbside can also be dropped at the DPW recycling center Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. In addition, waste oil is also accepted during these hours.

Please bring us your used motor oil! The DPW mechanic's shop is heated by a specially designed waste oil furnace. Your (and our) used motor oil helps us keep our heating bills low.



DPW RECYCLING CENTER – SATURDAY MATERIALS AND HOURS

The DPW Recycling Center is also open to residents on the Saturdays which the compactor is open for residential dumping:
April through November - the first and third Saturdays of the month from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
December through March - the first Saturday of the month from 8 a.m.-2 p.m.

ELECTRONICS

If it has a cord, it can be recycled! Charges will apply for TVs and monitors.



TIRES

A per tire charge will apply.



VEHICLE BATTERIES

Vehicle batteries are accepted at no charge.
