### Welcome

Thank you for attending this public involvement meeting for the N. Wilson Drive project. You are invited to view design concepts for the landscaping and storm water management aspects of the corridor including options for green infrastructure. Design ideas represent opportunities for present and future phases of the project. The reconstruction of N. Wilson Drive is currently planned to occur in 2018.

### Meeting Format & Purpose

This is an open house meeting. No formal presentation will be made. The purpose of this meeting is to gain feedback on the opportunities presented through design boards and project renderings. Please review the information presented and discuss ideas and questions with the project professionals present at each station.

### Station Descriptions



#### 1. Sign-in

#### 2. Roadway Design

- View changes in the design since the first public involvement meeting and discuss details with the roadway engineers.
- *The pedestrian median refuge* is proposed to be 10 feet wide face-of-curb to face-of-curb. Come walk through a sample footprint to experience this proposed space.



#### 3. Green Infrastructure & Landscape

- Engineers are considering bio-retention basins as part of the Phase 1 project construction in 2018.
- Existing trees will be removed for poor condition and conflict with the proposed design. New trees are proposed for the corridor.
- View concepts for the North Gateway entry way into the Village of Shorewood, including a table top intersection where Glendale Avenue meets Wilson Drive.



#### 4. Future Opportunities

- Future phases include ideas for a pilot site for the Global Water Council.
- Enhancement of the woodland area with native prairie grasses in the greenway gardens will improve habitat for birds, bees, and butterflies.

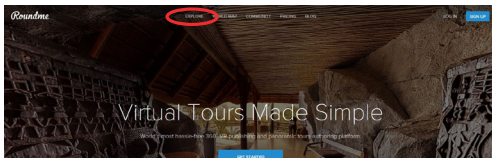


#### 5. Virtual Reality

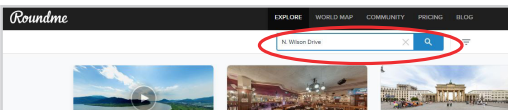
- Try on the goggles and take a virtual tour of the proposed plan of improvement.

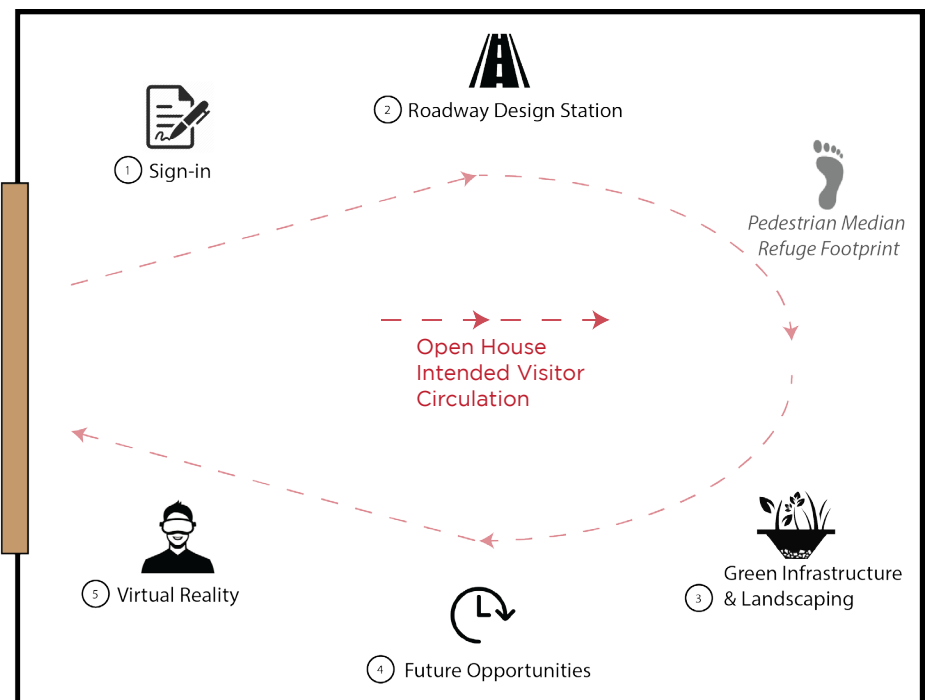

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### Traffic Control & Schedule

N. Wilson Drive will be open to bi-directional traffic during construction. MCTS Route 14 will remain in service on N. Wilson Drive and pedestrian and bicycle access to the Oak Leaf Trail will be maintained throughout construction.

This is the final public meeting planned for the project. The design remains on schedule for construction to begin in the spring of 2018, with the goal to be completed prior to November 1, 2018.
