Facility improvement recommendations from this report have been included in the Village's Long Range Financial Plan in a total of five phases. The phase initially scheduled to be funded in 2019 includes the construction of a Village-owned retaining wall on the east property line and the relocation of existing overhead utilities. Staff recommends a firm with architectural and engineering experience be retained to review the feasibility of these recommendations and develop detailed cost projections (in current dollars).
