CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Recyclables are collected curbside every other week by Waste Management under contract with the Village of Shorewood. For route and schedule information, please visit www.villageofshorewood.org/recycling

MATERIAL MUST BE PLACED INSIDE THE RECYCLING CART. MATERIAL OUTSIDE THE CART WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.



PAPER

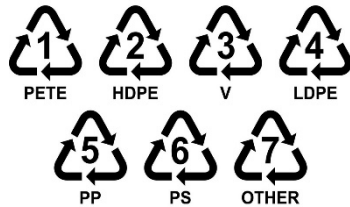
Newspapers, corrugated cardboard, paperboard, magazines, office paper, junk mail, phone books and paper cardboard dairy and juice cartons. **CARDBOARD MUST BE PLACED INSIDE THE CART.**



PLASTICS

Clean/rinsed food and other containers coded 1-7.

ITEMS MUST BE CODED



GLASS

Clean/rinsed clear, brown or green food or beverage containers.



METALS

Clean/rinsed aluminum cans, aluminum foil and bakeware, steel & tin.

Please! Only place these materials in your recycling cart. Other materials can contaminate the load and reduce the chances that any materials are recycled!

DPW RECYCLING CENTER – WEEKDAY MATERIALS AND HOURS

All materials collected curbside can also be dropped at the DPW recycling center Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. In addition, waste oil is also accepted during these hours.

Please bring us your used motor oil! The DPW mechanic's shop is heated by a specially designed waste oil furnace. Your (and our) used motor oil helps us keep our heating bills low.



DPW RECYCLING CENTER – SATURDAY MATERIALS AND HOURS

The DPW Recycling Center is also open to residents on the following Saturdays:
April through November – the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
December through March – the 1st Saturday of the month from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

ELECTRONICS

If it has a cord, it can be recycled! Charges apply.



TIRES

A per tire charge will apply.



VEHICLE BATTERIES

Vehicle batteries are accepted at no charge.
