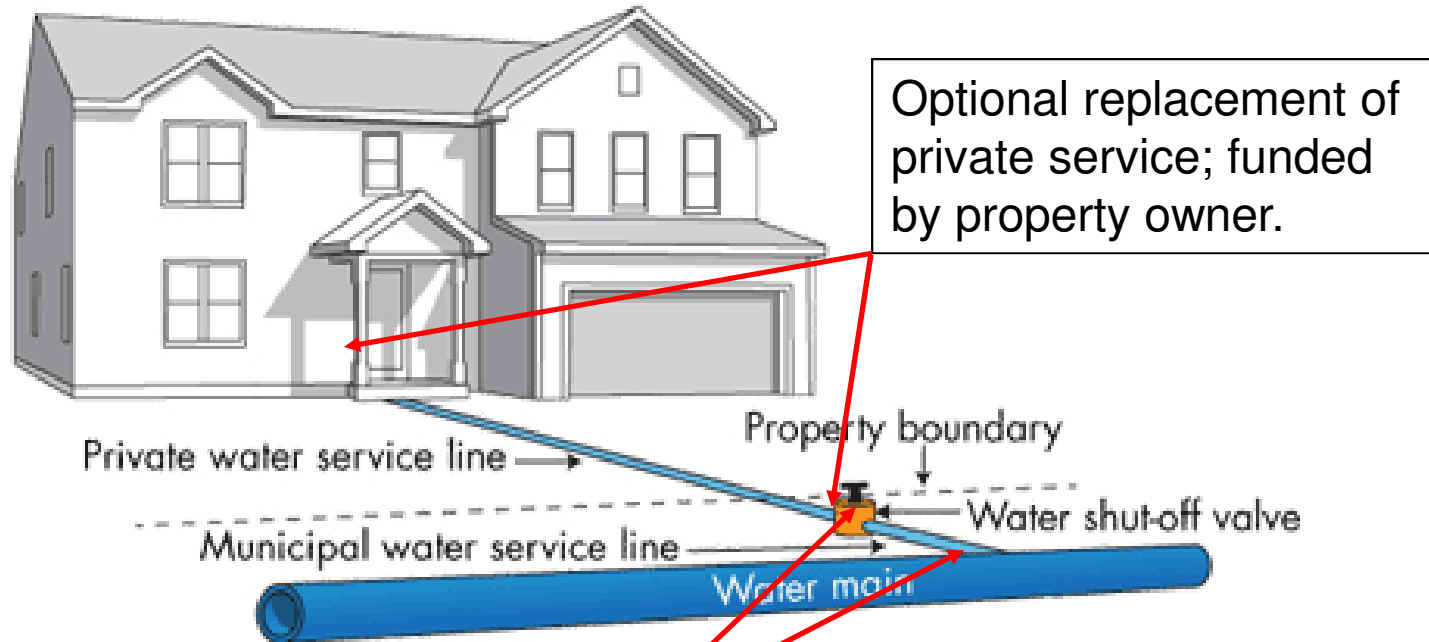

2019 Project Area



Water Service Ownership



All water services scheduled to be replaced to curb stop; funded by Water Utility.

Lead Service Replacement Policy



- Construction Impacted Residences
 - Baseline Lead Level Test Prior to Construction for Each Residence in Project Area
 - Second Test 30 days Following Service Connection/Reconnection
 - 10 Minute Daily Flush by Homeowner for a period of 4-6 weeks
 - Flush Allows Polyphosphate to Recoat the Service
 - Estimated that 60 day Flushing Period would Equate to a Total Water Use of Approximately 748 gallons or one billing unit. \$7.60 Credit is Provided on Utility Bills.
 - Upon Request Utility or NSHD will Provide Test Kits to Sample for Lead at Anytime. Homeowner is Responsible for Lab Fees.
 - Water Pitcher Certified for Lead Removal will be Provided.

Private Water Service Replacement



- Postcard Mailed January 7, 2019
- Follow-up Letter with Estimated Cost Information Mailed February 20, 2019
- Approximate Cost of \$6,670 per Service
 - Includes copper water tubing, meter setting, isolation valves, bends, fittings, concrete block wall or concrete floor repair, connection to existing plumbing
- Cost Assessed Over 5-year Period with 0% Annual Interest Rate
- Participation requires signed Agreement and Temporary Construction Easement by April 5, 2019



Access

- Driveway Access will be Limited at Times, Primarily when Construction is Near Driveway and During Paving
- Road Closed During Construction Hours
 - both sides of road to be posted “no parking”
 - parking outside of construction zone during working hours
- Garbage Collection will be Uninterrupted



Water Shutoffs



- Connection of Individual Water Services
- Connection of New Main to Existing Main
- Likely One to Two Additional Shutoffs
- Homeowners Are Notified 24-hours in Advance of Shutoffs

Private Side Service Installation



- Coordinated through the DPW
- Deadline for sign-up April 5, 2019
- Requires signed Agreement and Temporary Construction Easement
- Access to your basement and clear working zone around water meter
- Before and after pictures
- Work is completed in a day – someone 18yrs of age or older needs to be home
- Notify residents 1 week in advance of service replacement



Project Schedule Highlights

- Subject to change; weather permitting

April

Agreement Form for private service replacement due April 5, 2019

May

May 1st – construction begins; watermain install

Week of May 5th – watermain testing

Week of May 12th – Water service work

Week of May 19th – road restoration work begins; concrete curb installation

Week of May 26th – asphalt paving

June

Landscape restoration
