Dear Shorewood Resident/Property Owner:

The Village of Shorewood's 2019 infrastructure improvements include the reconstruction of several alleys within the Village. A contract for the work has been awarded to All-Ways Construction. The project is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of April 8, weather permitting.

A map of this year's project area can be found on the reverse of this letter. The project includes reconstruction of the following alley segments:

Alley 1	1500 - 1700 blocks East Beverly Road / East Newton Avenue
Alley 2A/2B	4000 block North Wilson Drive / North Woodburn Avenue (green alley)
Alley 3	4000 block of North Morris Boulevard / North Larkin Street
Alley 4A/4B	4300 block North Sheffield Avenue / North Marlborough Drive (green alley)
Alley 5	4400 block North Morris Boulevard / North Larkin Street
Alley 6	4400 block North Newhall Street / North Bartlett Avenue
Alley 7	4500 block North Woodburn Street / North Morris Boulevard
Alley 8	4500 block North Larkin Street / North Newhall Street

The project will include full reconstruction of the alleys including removal of existing pavement, stone base beneath the pavement and any unsuitable soils. Storm sewer will also be installed in key areas to improve drainage. The alleys will be repaved in asphalt. Alleys 2 and 4 will be reconstructed as "green alleys" incorporating stormwater quality features. 
Over the next several weeks you may notice activity in the project area, including tree trimming and more-frequent-than-normal utility location markings. Please note that property owners are responsible for marking – for the duration of the project – any existing private irrigation systems, underground fence systems or landscape lighting systems which may be located adjacent to the alley. Neither the Village nor the contractor will be responsible for any damage to such systems in the Village right-of-way but care will be taken to avoid marked systems when possible.

If you have plant materials in the alley right-of-way, please remove any plantings you wish to preserve prior to the start of the construction.
