

Situational Report for June 2, 2020

At approximately 9:48 pm, SHPD was advised there was a group on Water St. and N. Milwaukee St. looking to head north into Shorewood. SHPD monitored the movement of the group in order to determine if they would be approaching Shorewood.

At 10:55 pm, the group was at Oakland Avenue just south of E. Edgewood Ave., traveling Northbound on N. Oakland Ave. The first group was about 50 people with about 100 cars. There were no reports of violence but there were reports of reckless driving. Officers monitored the direction of the group in order to provide a safe route of passage for the group.

The main group arrived at Edgewood and Oakland at about 11:15 pm. The estimated size of the group at the time of arrival was approximately 100- 200 pedestrian protestors and 20-30 vehicles. Squads were deployed along Oakland Avenue from Edgewood to Capitol, with each intersection closed to prevent cross traffic from entering Oakland Ave. At 11:20 pm the group arrived at Oakland Avenue and Capitol Drive. They continued northbound on N. Oakland Ave. and into Whitefish Bay at 11:36 p.m.

At about 11:58 p.m. a Village of Whitefish Bay resident reported being threatened by someone who displayed a pistol in his waistband. Officers responded and located the suspect, the suspect fled WFB PD and took off into the yards. At about 12:16 a.m. on 6/3/20 the subject was taken into custody and the firearm was recovered from the suspect.

On 6/3/20 at about 12:35 a.m., the protest re-entered the village southbound on N. Wilson Dr. at E. Congress St. The group had mostly consolidated into the vehicles at this point as it had started raining. There were reports of someone throwing items at squads but there were no reports of any officers being injured or any squads being damaged. There was also reports and video of vehicles driving on lawns along N. Wilson Dr. and blocking the entire street. The group driving on both sides of the streets and were firing off fireworks. The group turned westbound on E. Capitol Dr. and proceeded into Milwaukee. At about 1:12 p.m. the group was out of Shorewood.

No arrests and no citations were issued.
