

RESOLUTION – 2020 - 14

A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING LOADING ZONE RENEWAL APPLICATION AND ANNUAL FEES FOR BUSINESSES ELIGIBLE FOR THE CDA'S EMERGENCY BUSINESS ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a novel strain of the coronavirus, was detected in December 2019 and has subsequently spread throughout numerous countries and the United States, including Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, international, federal, state, county and local governments are all working together to contain COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization's declaration of a Public Health Emergency of international concern and the United States' Department of Health and Human Services declaration of a Public Health Emergency, the State of Wisconsin has declared a Public Health Emergency by Executive Order #72; and

WHEREAS, the Village President of Shorewood by Resolution 2020-02, passed on March 16, 2020, declared a Public Health Emergency Response to COVID-19 coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 response has caused a dire economic situation for the Village of Shorewood and its for-profit businesses, having been closed or restricted in operation pursuant to Emergency Order #12 "Safer at Home" Order, may need financial assistance in the form of fee reduction; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, the Shorewood Community Development Authority approved an Emergency Business Assistance program the funding of which was confirmed by the Village Board on April 20, that will provide grant funding to eligible businesses, defined in part as "closed or significantly restricted;" and

WHEREAS, Shorewood Village Code 500-24 requires a Special Privilege Permit for the installation of a Loading Zone with a \$150 renewal application fee and annual fees of \$250 per 30 lineal feet and \$100 for each additional 10 lineal feet thereof for the period of May 1 through April 30; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood does hereby resolve that the renewal application and annual fees for eligible businesses as defined by the CDA's Emergency Business Assistance program be suspended for the period of May 1, 2020 – April 30, 2021.
