RESOLUTION 2021-20

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION CHARGES FOR THE SHOREWOOD MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY

WHEREAS, the Shorewood Municipal Water Utility has historically paid for the public fire protection charges due to the utility through the general tax levy; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. 196.03(3)(b) allows the Village Board to collect public fire protection charges either through the tax levy or as a direct charge on the utility bills; and

WHEREAS, changing the method of collections for these fees from the general tax levy to direct charges on the utility bills aligns the village's practices with those of our regional comparison communities; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, that the Village of Shorewood Municipal Water Utility hereby authorizes the public fire protection charge to be collected from general service water customers effective November 15, 2021, and that such a request is made to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin to establish those rates based on the equivalent meters method.
