

ORDINANCE NO. 3031

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 500-16 NIGHT PARKING

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood undertook a comprehensive Transportation and Parking Analysis in 2019, which was formally received by the Village Board on February 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Parking Analysis was guided by a Technical Advisory Group comprised of representative stakeholders who recommended receipt of the Analysis with the overarching goals to improve accessibility, ease communication, standardize regulations and improve enforcement;

WHEREAS, night parking regulations are currently located within the Village Code within Article VII Parking Limits and Regulations of Chapter 500 Vehicles and Traffic, and restrict overnight on-street parking to permit holders between the hours of 3:00 am and 5:00 am and require alternate-side parking on streets with sufficient width throughout the village;

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2021, within discussion of the requested update on implementation of the Analysis, the Village Board provided direction to staff to “Maintain on street overnight parking permits and update the enforcement time frame to 2:00 am to 5:00 am” to allow for greater enforcement coverage, and to “Discontinue alternate side parking on all Village streets except for N. Oakland Ave. and E. Capital Dr. (east of N. Oakland Ave). Enforcement of alternate side parking on these two streets would be performed seven days a week and holidays.”, as it was determined to be confusing to residents and less helpful than anticipated for the Department of Public Works and Police Department;

NOW THEREFORE, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on the 1st day of November 2021, by a favorable vote of the members being present and therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

Paragraph (3) of Subsection A “Restrictions” of Section 500-16 “Night parking” of Article VIII “Parking Limits and Regulations” of Chapter 500 “Vehicles and Traffic” shall be amended to read as follows:

- (3) Except as otherwise restricted or permitted under the Shorewood Village Code, no person shall park any other vehicle not listed in § 500-16A(2) on any Village street or highway between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on any day except Saturdays, Sundays or holidays.

SECTION 2

Paragraph (1) of Subsection B “On-street overnight parking permit” of Section 500-16 “Night parking” of Article VIII “Parking Limits and Regulations” of Chapter 500 “Vehicles and Traffic” shall be amended to read as follows:

- (1) Vehicles may be parked during the hours between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., provided that they shall first obtain an on-street overnight parking permit from the Village after filing an application and paying a permit fee, all as required under this section, and shall be parked as authorized by such permit, as provided in Subsection E.

SECTION 3

Paragraph (1) and subdivisions (a) and (b) of Subsection C "Alternate-side parking" of Section 500-16 "Night parking" of Article VIII "Parking Limits and Regulations" of Chapter 500 "Vehicles and Traffic" shall be amended to read as follows, and paragraph (2) shall be eliminated:

- (1) Vehicles parked on N. Oakland Ave. or E. Capitol Drive east of N. Oakland Ave. pursuant to this section authorizing night parking shall be parked:
 - (a) On the oddly addressed side of the street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on odd days of the calendar; and
 - (b) On the evenly addressed side of the street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on even days of the calendar.

SECTION 4

Paragraph (1) "Holidays." of Subsection F "Exceptions." of Section 500-16 "Night parking" of Article VIII "Parking Limits and Regulations" of Chapter 500 "Vehicles and Traffic" shall be amended to read as follows:

- (1) Holidays. Except as provided in subsection C of this subsection relating to alternate-side parking and Article XII of this chapter relating to parking during snow emergencies, this section shall not be effective and in force on the following: on the morning of, and the morning following, the first day of January, New Year's Day; last Monday in May, Memorial Day; July 4, Independence Day; first Monday in September, Labor Day; fourth Thursday in November, Thanksgiving Day; and December 25, Christmas Day.


SECTION 5

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

SECTION 6

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting commencing December 1, 2021.
